Dear Judge Holland:

The Trustees of Reclamation District No. 2030, McDonald Island, hereby submit their response to the San Joaquin County Grand Jury Final Report – Case No. 0113.

As District Counsel and Secretary, it was my responsibility to file the required response, and apologize for the late filing. My failure to file this response was entirely inadvertent.

Here is RD 2030's response to the Grand Jury Final Report and the specific recommendations therein set forth:

RECOMMENDATIONS R.1.1, R.1.2 AND R.1.3

As to R.1.1 and R.1.2, District Counsel has represented RD 2030 for nearly 30 years. While no formal contract is required, RD 2030 will adopt a contract with its legal counsel which meets the requirements described in the recommendations which will be effective as of the commencement of Fiscal Year 2015-2016. As to R.1.3, RD 2030 adopted its first written contract with its engineering consulting firm (Kjeldsen Sinnock) approximately eight months ago. That contract complies with the recommendations of the Grand Jury.


RECOMMENDATION R.2

RD 2030 submitted budgets for the years covered by the Grand Jury's survey, has maintained annual budgets for many years, and adopts budgets for each fiscal year as a matter of standard practice.

RECOMMENDATIONS R.3.1 AND R.3.2.

RD 2030 has met with LAFCO and is in the process of completing the Municipal Services Review Questionnaire which will be filed with LAFCO by June 17, 2015. LAFCO has consented to the filing date.
