SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT WILL BE CLOSED ONE DAY PER MONTH

The California judicial branch is facing severe budget reductions due to the statewide financial crisis. In response to this crisis, last week the California Judicial Council approved the closure of all state courts on the third Wednesday of each month, from September 2009 through June 2010. This approval came after the court closures were approved by the Governor and Legislature as part of budget trailer bill (Senate Bill X4 13) to the 2009 - 2010 Budget Act. The first court closure is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, September 16, 2009.
