IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF

EFFECTIVE JUNE 20, 2020

On April 1, 2020, the San Joaquin County Superior Court modified the 2019-2020 Uniform Bail Schedule adopted by the Judges of San Joaquin County Superior Court and further ordered certain additional measures pursuant to the March 30, 2020 Emergency Order issued by the Honorable Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chief Justice of California.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- Effective June 20, 2020, in response to the Judicial Council's vote to rescind Emergency Rule 4, the April 1, 2020 San Joaquin County Superior Court General Order: County-Wide Emergency Bail Schedule is rescinded and San Joaquin County shall return to the original 2019-2020 Bail Schedule; and,
- Effective June 20, 2020, San Joaquin County shall adhere to the statutory deadline provided in Penal Code, section 825, and bring a defendant charged with a felony offense before a magistrate within forty-eight (48) hours.
