**NOTICE OF CHANGE IN  
ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO COURT RECORDS**

***Effective Friday, April 1, 2011***

Effective Friday, April 1, 2011, the public will no longer be able to electronically access the following records on-line through the court's website:

- (1) Records in a proceeding under the Family Code, including proceedings for dissolution, legal separation, and nullity of marriage; child and spousal support proceedings; child custody proceedings; and domestic violence prevention proceedings;
- (2) Records in a juvenile court proceeding;
- (3) Records in a guardianship or conservatorship proceeding;
- (4) Records in a mental health proceeding;
- (5) Records in a criminal proceeding;
- (6) Records in a civil harassment proceeding under Code of Civil Procedure section 527.6;
- (7) Records in a workplace violence prevention proceeding under Code of Civil Procedure section 527.8;
- (8) Records in an elder or dependent adult abuse prevention proceeding under Welfare and Institutions Code section 15657.03; and
- (9) Records in proceedings to compromise the claims of a minor or a person with a disability.

**While electronic access to the records listed above will not be available on the court's website, the public can access these records electronically using kiosks located in clerk's offices or by seeking help at clerk's counters.** The planned change will make the court in compliance with California Rules of Court 2.503 (<http://courts.ca.gov/7260.htm?title=two>), which became effective January 1, 2010 and outlines the public's access to court records.

**The changes effective April 1, 2011 will not impact remote electronic access of court calendars, register of actions, and tentative rulings currently available on the court's website.**
